#### **HYMN NOTES:**

### "From All That Dwell Below the Skies" (327)

This hymn by the "father of English hymnody," Isaac Watts (1674-1748) is based on the two verses that make up the shortest psalm (117):

Praise the Lord, all you nations! Extol him, all you peoples! For great is his steadfast love toward us, And the faithfulness of the Lord endures forever. *Praise the Lord!* 

Our stanzas 1 and 3 are by Watts in 1719. Because of the brevity of the hymn, most hymnal editors have added additional stanzas, mostly of unknown origin like our stanza 2. In many ways Psalm 117 shares the assumptions of the first question of the Westminster Shorter Catechism: "O. What is the chief end of man" A. Man's chief end is to glorify God, and to enjoy him forever."


