HYMN NOTES:

"Lead On, O King Eternal" (269)

The opening hymn today was written with an eye to the future. Ernest W. Shurtleff penned the hymn for his 1887 graduating class of Andover Theological Seminary. This hymn, like "Onward, Christian Soldiers" calls the faithful to fight in a war against sin to establish God's kingdom of peace and love—without fear. The context of the hymn changes as we use it now; the conclusion of worship replaces graduation as "the day of march" that follows "days of preparation" into "fields of conquest." The rousing marching tune by the self-taught English organist and composer, Henry Smart, adds to the excitement of the call to march. Smart also wrote the tune REGENT SQUARE ("Angels, from the Realms of Glory.")


