In March we went on our spring break mission to Beth El Farm Workers Community in partnership with Cedarkirk Camp & Conference Center. Thank you for all of the words of encouragement and prayers for our Spring Break Mission Trip. Our students: Annabelle, Sarah, Joyce, Aly, Dylan, Kaleb, Adam, Joey, Lucas, Isaac, Eli and Mathew, with my chaperones to help me lead this trip, Dan and Roxie. We spent the majority of the day working at Beth El then would go back to camp to participate in various camp activities like playing in the river, cooking our meal over the fire and spending time outdoors. We'd end the night with social justice & servant-minded devotion and session. This was a week full of learning and trying new things, working together and witnessing God's work through the power of community. We transformed two sheds into a workshop and facilities maintenance space; a much-needed project that will allow them to serve their community further. Our youth went above and beyond to use their spiritual gifts together to make this happen. We are so proud of them for choosing to spend their spring break in this way and take the necessary preventative steps to keep us safe before and during the trip. We are so grateful for our relationship with Beth El & Cedarkirk and all that they have taught us.

As for April, we have resumed our 2020 confirmation class with plans to have an outdoor confirmation service in late May. We will be meeting a few times in April to refresh, reflect and move forward.
