
New Church Voice/Data Services Installation/Implementation Dates

Last Fall, the Property Ministry Team recommended that we contract with Spectrum Enterprises for new voice/data services at Northwood. The implementation process has been ongoing since that time and after

Easter, the new services will be installed and become operational. Fiber optic circuits will replace our existing coax cable from Spectrum and voice services will be provided over internet protocol rather than the current lines from Frontier. Most of this will be unseen, but new phone sets are also part of the service. We want you to know that on **April 19**, the fiber optic circuit will be installed and the data services will go live that day or the next. We do not anticipate any problems and expect that once fully operational, everything about the new services will surpass the old. But, with any new implementation of voice or data services, there is a chance that things may not go as planned. If you have trouble watching the Brown Bag Bible Study on Thursday of that week or church services that Sunday, know that it is most likely the result of managing the switch over to the new services and we will be working very hard to resolve any issues. We are asking in advance for your patience and understanding. Hopefully you'll only see positive results. The voice portion of the new services will be switched over on **April 26 and 27**. Again, we don't anticipate and problems, but if for some reason you have trouble reaching the church office on either of those days, know that we are in the midst of this process and issues will be resolved as soon as possible.

nied choral groups and small ensembles and was active in the local arts community.


