

Ring, Sing & Mingle- Our annual Christmas Handbell Concert, Carol Sing and Reception, December 11th at 4:00pm.


Christmas Cantata- "Festival of Christmas" by Mary McDonald with large choir and instruments, December 18th

Kings' Kids is BACK!


