

Every year we send 40-50 children to Cedarkirk for a weeklong adventure at camp. Many of our older youth tell us how important this experience was in their walk of faith. Summer camp gives our kids the opportunity to mingle with other children their age from other parts of Florida and the nation. It works toward breaking down stereotypes, and serves as a reminder of our interconnectivity. Once again, thank you for your donation. Your donation is quite important to those we service!
