There are a good number of important events to place at Northwood during the month of February that you do not want to miss! Several of them are highlighted by articles in this edition of our newsletter. Allow me to summarize them hereí

The Annual Meeting of the congregation will be Sunday, January 28th at Noon. The business to be conducted is listed inside. There will be no luncheon this year following the annual meeting as in yeargs past, as the luncheon will be held instead on Sunday, February 18, to celebrate the 40th Anniversary of Northwood Presbyterian Church.

On Sunday, February 11th will be Scout Sunday and the pancake breakfast they annually host for all of us. This is the first year in which we will celebrate our scout programs on the second Sunday of the month instead of the first Sunday. It is a great tradition to have all our scouts and their parents in worship that day and get the chance to visit with them at breakfast.

Wednesday, February 14th is our Ash Wednesday worship service at 6:45. It will also be the first Wednesday dinner of our Wednesday And You, (WAY) dinners which always begin at 6:00 p.m. The dinner dates are February 14, 21, 28 and March 7, 14, & 21. Menus of the meals and the name of the study will be provided in early February.

I hope you will plan to attend worship on Sunday, February 18 as we celebrate 40 years as a congregation, followed by a special covered dish luncheon. We will have our annual Kirkinø oø the Tartan worship service with a special pipe band and tartan processional at all three worship services that day. Kirkin' o' the Tartan

40th Anniversary year of Northwood Presbyterian Church Sunday, February 18, 2018

In 1745, Scottish clansmen were forbidden by the British Crown to wear the tartans, and to play the bagpipes, and to acknowledge in any way their traditional clans. This prompted the stubborn Scots to secretly carry with them a piece of their tartans in their pockets as they went to church (kirk). On an appointed Sunday, the minister would slip into the service a blessing, or "kirkin"

for the tartans and clans which the tartans represented.

Our Kirkin' will be a celebration of the Scottish reformers as well as all those who have gone before us in the faith.
