Mantos y palmas (Filled with excitement) #199

This Palm Sunday hymn is based on the account of Jesus' entry into Jerusalem in Matthew 21:8-9. Only two stanzas with a refrain, it was composed in 1972 by Rubén Ruíz Avila (words and music) for the choir of the United Methodist Church in Covington, Virginia where he and his sons were members. This is the first and presumably only composition by Avila. This is the hymn's first appearance in a Presbyterian hymnal.
