HYMN NOTES: "How Can I Keep from Singing? (My Life Flows On")

It was attributed to the early Quakers, also to the Shakers, then Baptist minister Robert Lowry claimed it as his. The fact is it was first published in the New York Observer on August 7, 1868 and titled "Always Rejoicing." The author was listed as "Pauline T." Lowry published it with his tune in his 1869 songbook "Bright Jewels for the Sunday School." During the 20th century, this hymn was not widely used in congregational worship. Diehl's index to a large number of hymnals from 1900 to 1966 indicates that only one hymnal included it: the 1940 edition of The Church Hymnal of the Seventh-day Adventist Church. The United Methodist Church published it in its 2000 hymnal supplement, The Faith We Sing.

It was popularized in the 1970's by folk singer Pete Seeger and then in 1991 by the Irish singer, Enya. Both changed some of the overtly Christian words of the original but several recent hymnals have included the hymn (with much of the original text) including Glorv to God at #821.

The opening bell piece on this tune was one of the selections at the Eighth Florida State Handbell Festival held last weekend and at which Northwood's two adult bell choirs participated. It was arranged in 2014 by the director of the Festival, Cathy Moklebust.
