

**Hymn Notes:**

**“Have No Fear Little Flock”**

Heinz Werner Zimmermann (b. 1930) wrote the music and the first stanza in 1971 based on the scripture Luke 12:32. It features the syncopations of his jazz-flavored church music. Marjorie Jillson (b. 1931) wrote three further stanzas and the piece was published in *Five Hymns* (1973). Jillson was from Detroit and graduated from Wooster College of Ohio. She spent her life employed as a secretary until she became ill. A member of the Grosse Point Memorial Presbyterian Church she wrote eight published hymn texts, all the music composed by Zimmermann. We hear two stanzas today of “...Little Flock” as the Sung Blessing.

**11:00 A.M. Experiencing God Class Room 15**, led by Vicki Krueger, will resume today, September 9th! Come join us!

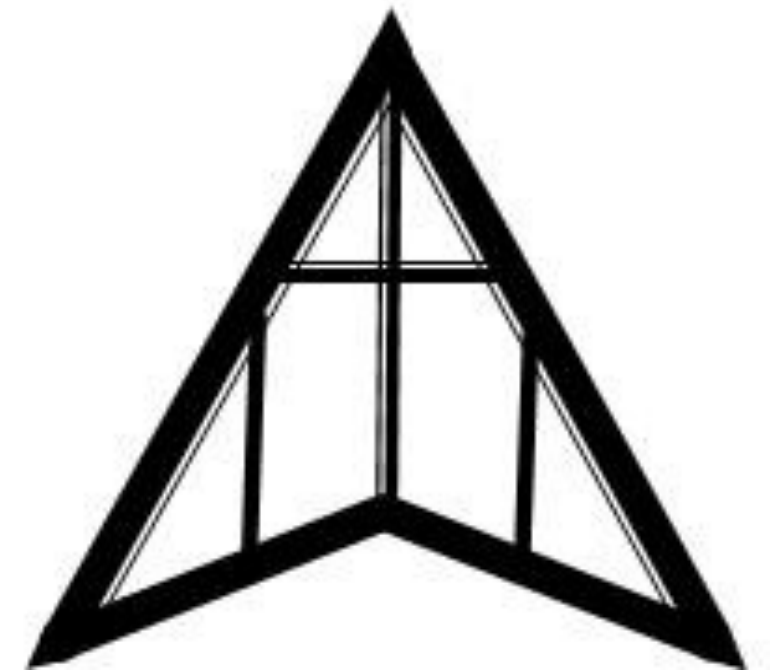
**11:00 A.M. "Journey Through" Room 4**, led by Vanessa Celotto.
