MUSIC NOTES:

When Jesus Wept (194)

The shortest verse in the New Testament is John 11:35 consisting of just two words, "Jesus wept." This is part of today's narrative about the raising of Lazarus from the dead. The anthem and music at the offering are based on an early American tune by William Billings (1746-1800). This tune was composed to be sung in canon. Billings was a life-long resident of Boston and was a tanner by trade who was a largely self-taught musician. Billings wrote "the first collection of music entirely by an American" which is called *New England Psalm-Singer* and in which "When Jesus Wept" was included. He actively taught in the New England singing schools his entire life. He was also physically disabled having only one eye, a short leg and a withered arm along with being addicted to snuff and neglecting normal matters of hygiene. Billings' work was very popular in its heyday, but his career was hampered by the primitive state of copyright law in America at the time. By the time the copyright laws had been strengthened, it was too late for Billings: the favorites among his tunes had already been widely reprinted in other people's hymnals, permanently copyright-free. He died in poverty.
