We got our acts together and a Night on the Towne is BACK! Mark your calendars, **Saturday, October 15.**

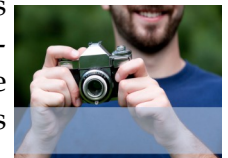
Memorial Service
