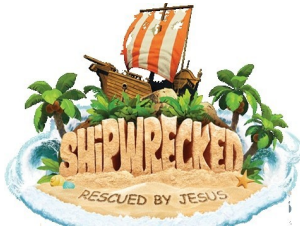
Fun! Friends! Friday! Ren Crew
