Hymn Notes:

"Praise Ye the Lord, the Almighty" (35)

The beautiful hills, valleys, and flowing streams in the Dusseldorf area of now western Germany provided the inspiration for this hymn by Joachim Neander (1650-1680). A brilliant young man, both a teacher and a pastor, was well known despite his short life. He died a few months after writing this hymn. Neander enjoyed the seclusion he found in the valley of the small stream of Dussel. This valley was named the Neanderthal Valley for him, and almost two hundred years later, in 1856, a skeleton was discovered there that was thought to represent a race of people who lived in western Europe as early as 4000 B.C. It was named the Neanderthal man.

While the German hymn was written more than three hundred years ago, the English translation was made and published in 1863 by Catherine Winkworth of London. She was regarded as one the finest translators of the German language and helped make German hymns popular in England during the 19<sup>th</sup> century. She also was the translator of "Now Thank We All Our God."




### 6:30 P.M. Sunday Evening Bible Study
