Hymn Notes:

"Let All Things Now Living" (37)

The author of this hymn, Katherine K. Davis (1892-1980), wrote the text around 1925 but did not publish it until 1938 when it appeared as an anthem text. Even then, she used a frequent pseudonym, a rare occurrence in hymn publishing. Strangely enough, a different hymn using the same Welsh tune was published the same way under a pseudonym by Omer Westendorf in 1964. That hymn we hear today at the Sung Blessing. The common tune for both is THE ASH GROVE that had its ancient origins in Wales and was made popular in England by Welsh harpists in the 17th through 19th centuries.




6:30 P.M. Sunday Evening Bible Study
