Hymn Notes:

"The God of Abraham Praise" (49)

This text has a long and complex history beginning with a set of thirteen articles of Jewish faith known as the *Yigdal*, based on the imagery of Daniel 7 as written down by Moses Maimonides in the 12th century and versified around 1400 by Daniel ben Judah. After hearing the famous cantor Meyer Lyon sing it in Hebrew at the Great Synagogue in London, Thomas Olivers made a Christianized adaptation of it in English. Another translation was also made and the two were blended in *The Hymnal*, 1933—the Presbyterian hymnal. The tune is based on one of the traditional melodies for the Hebrew *Yigdal*. Although lore associated with this tune claims that it was sung at the dedication of Solomon's Temple, it's more likely that it was about 100 years old when the cantor Meyer Lyon sang it to Thomas Olivers in 1770. Because of its Jewish and folkloric associations this tune has found its way into several pieces of classical music such as Rossini's oratorio *Moses in Egypt* and Smetana's *The Moldau*.

6:30 P.M. Sunday Evening Bible Study


