


**Hymn Notes:**  
**“All Hail the Power of Jesus’ Name! (263)**  
This hymn is by Edward Perronet who was of Swiss Hugenot ancestry, but born in England in 1726. He was a son of a close friend and advisor of the Wesleys and Edward himself was for many years an ardent worker for Methodism, at times suffering physical abuse for his preaching. Differences arose between Perronet and the Wesleys about whether itinerant preachers should also administer the sacraments and over Perronet’s attacks on the Church of England which John and Charles Wesley never left. The tune, named CORONATION, is by the Massachusetts native Oliver Holden (1765-1844). The tune occupies a special place in the history of church music in the U.S. It is the most frequently used and most often re-printed tune to emerge in this country during the 18<sup>th</sup> century, making it the oldest American tune in continuous use.
