

## HYMN NOTES:

### “Lord of All Good” (711)

This hymn, which also appeared in *The Presbyterian Hymnal* 1990, was written for Eccleston Congregational Church’s Christmas Fair of 1962 by Albert F. Bayly, who was then the pastor. He was British and served several churches in England during his long pastoral career (1929-1972). He first studied to be a shipbuilder before being ordained and was made a fellow of Westminster Choir College, Princeton NJ in 1972 and honored at Westminster Abbey in 1978. The tune is a shortened form of OLD 124<sup>TH</sup> which was first published in the Genevan Psalter in 1551.

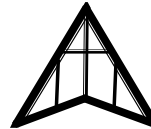
