MUSIC NOTES:

John Rutter was born in 1945 in London and studied music at Clare College, Cambridge where from 1975-1979 he was Director of Music and directed the college chapel choir in various recordings and broadcasts. Since then, he has divided his time between composition and conducting. Most of his music that we are presenting today is from around 1981 and published in two collections titled *O Holy Night* and *Joy to the World*. His music is performed around the world and has featured in a number of British royal occasions, including the two most recent royal weddings. Along with Sir David Willcocks (1919-2015), Rutter co-edited four volumes of *Carols for Choirs* that have become standard arrangements for choirs worldwide. In 1983 he formed his own professional choir, The Cambridge Singers, with whom he has made numerous recordings.
