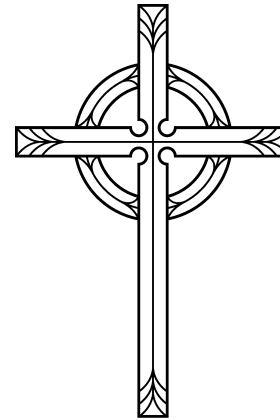
From childhood Brad was a huge Gators fan which led to him attending college at the University of Florida where he attended many games with his friends.
