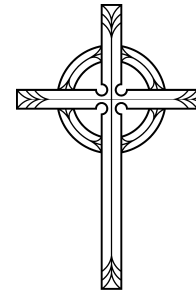

Her various careers were mostly in sales including owning a Honda dealership and a real estate business in Asheville, NC, Pampered Pets in Countryside Mall in Clearwater and a Petland in Toledo, OH. Her last jobs before retirement included sales positions for Home Shopping and Accents & Gifts in the Tampa Bay area.
