"WAY" to Go



The first Wednesday dinner will be March 6th and will begin at 6:00 PM. Following the meal together, we will have an Ash Wednesday Service at 6:45 P.M. in the Sanctuary. The rest of the study series will be held in the Christian Education Building following the Wednesday meal.
